

PATHWAY TO RUSSIAN MINOR

Complete 8 units comprising:

0 to 4 units from Russian Level 1 Beginner Elective Courses, and

4 units for all Russian Level 2 Intermediate Compulsory Courses, and

0 to 4 units from Russian Level 2 Elective Courses

Students beginning Russian should start with Level 1 Courses; those who are at intermediate level should start with Level 2 Courses. Students should consult https://languages-cultures.uq.edu.au/study/whats-my-language-level to determine their starting point and receive more detailed information about the Courses to complete according to their language level.
