

## PATHWAY TO FRENCH ADVANCED MAJOR

Complete 16 units comprising:

- 0 to 2 units from French Advanced Level 2 Continuing Courses, and
- 0 to 4 units from French Advanced Level 2 Elective Courses, and
- 0 to 2 units from French Advanced Level 3 Continuing Courses, and
- 6 units for all French Advanced Level 3 Compulsory Courses, and
- 2 to 10 units from French Advanced Level 3 Elective Courses

Students who completed Year 12 French should start with the Level 2 continuing course; those who are at advanced level should start with Level 3 compulsory courses. The Level 2 elective courses are open to all students. Students should consult <https://languages-cultures.uq.edu.au/study/whats-my-language-level> to determine their starting point and receive more detailed information about the courses to complete according to their language level.
